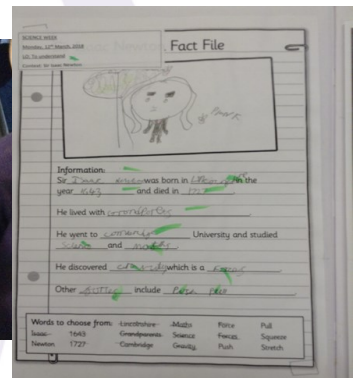

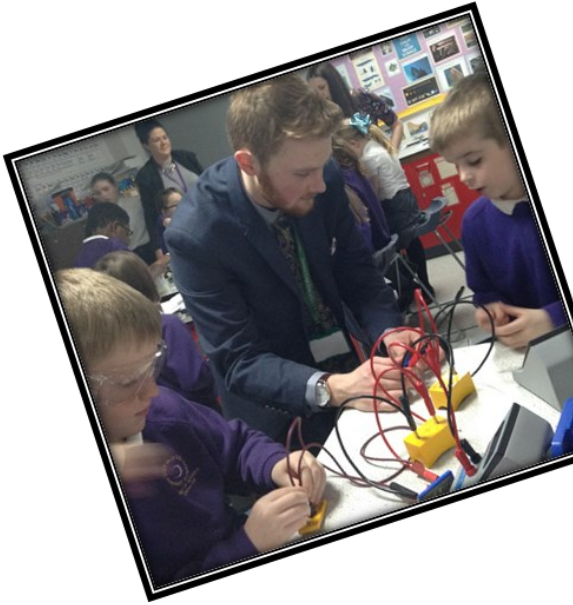

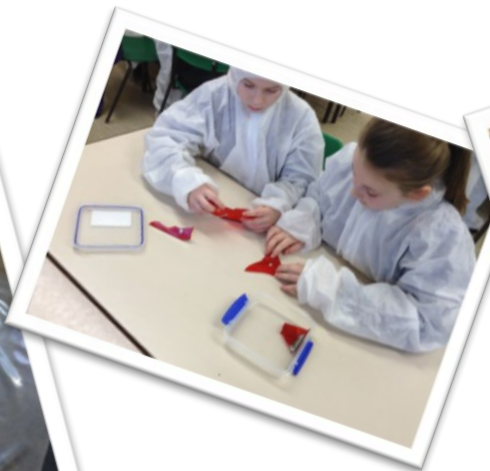

Science Week

3/4 LWKW visited the Science labs at Outwood Grange. They tried out lots of exciting investigations and experiments. They have been learning about states of matter and learnt about the water cycle and conducted experiments to see which type of water freezes first.



In Year 5 children Linked science with their Crime & Punishment topic, they explored how forensic science has changed the way we investigate crime. They dusted for prints, swabbed for DNA, and looked at techniques such as chromatography during their CSI day.



Y6 worked with Mrs Stephenson to dissect flowers. They took part in a scientific investigation afternoon, where they learnt about the centre of gravity; how our taste buds work and we watched raisins 'dance'. They also studied the famous scientist Stephen Hawking.
